HOW TO POSITION ASSEMBLY PARTS




To avoid strong friction during the suspension movement, it is extremely important that the following parts are correctly positioned:



- Put the new shock absorber in a strut clamp.
 Extend the sleeve side of bottom eye towards the left (arrow).
 - 2. Align the spring cushions to the axle of the bottom eye mounting (arrow).



3. Rubber spring block to be positioned in such a way that the coil end fits to the rubber end (with arrow on rubber).




4. Position upper seat as follows: Bolt Mounting holes are to be aligned with the grooves in the rubber spring block.



Using Monroe® K81:

- 5. Assemble all strut parts and tighten central nut only by hand.
- **6.** Insert lower positioning pin of K 81 with dia 10 mm in the lower mounting eye of the shock absorber.
- 7. Put the alignment seat of K81. Put 2 bolts M8 through the holes marked
- "A4 REAR L + R" and screw through the upper spring seat hole



- Axis A = Bottom eye mounting actually turned 50° (a) to axis B = Upper Spring seat (+/-2°).
- Top fixing lugs to be positioned as follows:
- -axis C = fixing lugs turned 90° to
- •axis A = bottom eye mounting.

LEFT AND RIGHT SPRING SEAT UNIT ARE IDENTICAL PARTS
