a) Unplug the connector from the Brake Light Switch

switch is when supplied is in a "deactivated" state.

- b) Remove the old Brake Light Switch by turning approx. 45 degrees to left.
- c) Take the new SMPE Brake Light Switch
 NOTE: This type of Switch contains an internal mechanism, which can be damaged
 if not installed and adjusted correctly. The Switch can only be tested when it is fitted. The
- d) Maintain the brake pedal in its rest position.

 IMPORTANT: Support the pedal in its rest position whilst installing the switch.

 Insert the Switch into the hole in the pedal box from where the old switch was removed, it has only one possible position. Press the plunger against the pedal. The switch has to be turned to the right approx. 45 degrees obtaining the definitive assembly position. The switch is now "activated" and can be electrically tested and checked.
- e) Refit the Brake Light Switch connector and test the brake lights are working. The procedure will need to be repeated, if not.
- f) Erase any brake light related fault codes after installing the new switch.
