Fitment advice

The water pump is supplied with a plastic cover that is required to be in a certain position during fitment. In between the factory and the installer the cover can move around in the box (Picture A).

The water pump and plastic cover fit together with the help of two protrusions (Picture B). It is important to ensure that the water pump and plastic cover are fitted together correctly before trying to fit to the engine (Picture C).

The timing cover has a recess to locate the plastic cover into during fitment (Picture D). The plastic cover will not fit into the timing cover recess if it is not fitted correctly onto the water pump.





